Pastor Santos and Elizabeth have agreed to stay on for a few more weeks to help with our anniversary celebration of 10 years in the church of San Lorenzo November 10, 11 and 12. We have also invited Robert Hugo Paniagua Arroyo to preach during this time. He has recently graduated from the Bible Institute associated with our mission.
