Ryan enjoyed his time at Western Seminary in Portland last month and is halfway through his first semester of school. It's a new challenge balancing ministry, family, and studies, but he's truly thankful for the opportunity to learn. He has already grown a lot through his classes.

This semester Ryan's ministry is focused on mentoring one of our Japanese student leaders and two interns and an exchange student from the United States. He also attended our annual Personal Evangelism Seminar (11/3-4) last week with about 30 other staff and students. It was encouraging to see many of the students sharing their faith for the first time during the outreach afterwards.
