How are you? The monsoon rains have now started here in Kyoto, which is appropriate considering the deluge of activity we have faced over the past few months. Here are a few of the highlights:

- From 3/8-10, Cru in Japan hosted its first **National Spring Camp** since 2019. More than 60 staff and students attended.
- On 3/31, Ryan was officially appointed Team Leader of the Kyoto ministry at our **Transition Ceremony** (see photo above).
- From 4/1-7, our team passed out almost 3,000 fliers on 6 campuses. As a result, several new students got connected to our community.
- On 4/14, we began meeting for large group Bible study every Friday night at a local church. About a dozen students now attend regularly.
- From 5/13-6/2, we hosted 2 teams of American college students on **Vision Trips**. We pray some might return to serve with us long-term.

Besides the events above, we have been settling into our weekly routine of team meetings, coaching appointments, fellowship with Christian students, and campus evangelism. It has been hard work relaunching the Kyoto ministry after Covid. But God has also been at work in many ways to build momentum, and we are excited about what lies ahead.
