We had our very first Zoom teaching session at the seminary this month. Dr. Dave Hook taught the freshman class all week on the principals of Evangelism. The teaching was wonderful and the students enjoyed the new format and engaged Dave with may questions all week. Starlink is our communication tool, and it is lightning fast. The team of translators did a tremendous job and I had the privilege of facilitating the Q&A times all week.

In my conversations with the board members of the seminary, I hear over and over how important it is to the school and students to have 20% of the teachers outside of Haiti teach the students. Those teachers provide a broader context and a sense of connection to the church
