God's timing

While in Haiti last month Wiljean shared with me what God had placed on his heart. To plant churches and to plant crops that support ministry. He told me about 40 acres that had been given to the ministry and I asked to see it.

During the drive I sensed Wiljean's excitement for all that was possible with God in this place. Upon arriving I could see the land was cleared and tilled, but nothing was planted. He told me that last year crops had been planted, but the cows roaming around kept pushing- over the fence and eating the crops and nothing grows in the 6 month dry season without irrigation, "trouble for farmers in Haiti, but we can overcome this", he said.

He asked if THM could help with bringing the acreage into use year round with water for crops and also help with keeping the cows away. I told him I would pray and see how God leads.

I left Haiti the following day (Thursday) and met a fellow missionary on my flight home. We talked about God, ministry in Haiti, and the acreage in need of help. As the plane landed he asked to keep the conversation going and I agreed. We had a follow up conversation on the following Wednesday morning and another that afternoon discussing ways to buoy ministry operations for our friends in Haiti. I could sense my new friends heart, we share the same mark for serving God's own, sharing what we have and know with those God has put on the front lines, those who bring the life changing Gospel of Jesus to the poor. We hung up and no longer than a moment I had an email from PayPal informing me THM had received a

donation from my new friend! A donation in the amount to drill a well, purchase a pump and an electrical fence to keep cows away. I never asked for a donation, but God provided. WOW!

I called Wiljean to tell him the great news and he said he had something to tell me after I finish.



40 acres now filled with banana trees

He told me that his wife received a call on Friday (the day after I left Haiti) from a banana plantation manager that heard about the farm land. He wanted to surprise Wiljean with 3,500 banana trees for the ministry. WOW! Wiljean's wife called around and had 20 volunteers work two full days planting the trees. Then she informed her husband of the news.

In one week - God transformed the land for His glory and for the spreading of His Word!
