



#### Seminary needs 2022/2023

The annual operating budget for the seminary is \$24k (\$16k for teachers and staff /\$8k for food)

Land, wells, barns and animals have been supplied to offset these expenses but the farm is experiencing supply chain obstacles and is not in a position yet to fully fund the seminary. Fencing has been soooo expensive for more than 18 months (2x our budget) that we have been hindered in the number of animals we can purchase and safely manage.

Result... We need direct financial support to operate the seminary this school year and next, until the herd grows in size.

## ANOTHER CHURCH PLANTED

Thank you partners for helping our ministry partner in Haiti continue to walk in the plan God is leading them on. Pastor Wisman, a student from the seminary, has been selected to lead this congregation and was announced July 25th at the first celebration.

Reminder, (*multiple ways church's are planted*) Once a location has been identified for a new church plant, members from the church network are sent to the village a week before the first

celebration. Teams evangelize in the streets, announce the new church location, construct the building, host nightly worship events and prepare the food. Then Sunday's service celebration.

THM will be suppling Pastor Wisman with a motorcycle to get to/from the village and seminary. Pray for Pastor Wisman and this new congregation.
