Twelve friends from Iowa partnered with THM this month to do life alongside the church in Lacieenne. Building an additional water tank for irrigation systems and birthing stalls for the goat farm; in addition to plastering & painting the worship center, they also waged an epic water balloon battle with the kids. Thank you, team; you immensely blessed the church in Lacieenne!

During the painting of the church building Pastor Oclane told me the catholic church (where in Haiti voodoo is mixed in) has been spreading lies about Pastor Oclane and the church leaders. They have been telling people in Lacieenne that Christ alone is not enough and that they need to do certain works in addition to be saved. This same catholic church not far from us used a lie that unpainted church buildings are a sign that God is not blessing a congregation. Ha! We know Christ alone is sufficient, we know paint is just paint, but laboring together painting God's house was on this day a powerful sign to the unbelievers in the Haitian community that God sent a team to show himself glorious. Praise God for how creative He is in brining glory to Jesus.

Nathan is a member of the church in Lacieenne. He had been sad as he had not a tithe to offer his beloved church. When Pastor Oclane announced the need for masonry work at the worship center he swiftly offered to plastered and paint it giving his time and talent as a tithe; and they joy is evident.



The Chinese are building a large road in Haiti and one of it crew members was scouting for masons. He saw Nathan working with great skill on the church building and asked him if he wanted a job with their crew. Nathan was overjoyed to reply and now Nathan is a foreman on the crew. Nathan is giving his testimony next week to the congregation. Prayers, paint, goats, irrigation, crops, water balloons, money, guitars, bibles, medicine, people... all tools God uses for His Glory.
