## IS THE BIBLE RELIABLE?




This was the question posed on dozens of flyers all around UMass Boston (UMB) a week ago, inviting people to a special event hosted by Cru at UMB. Our students put together this roundtable discussion event for their fellow students where people could come enjoy a meal, listen to a talk on the reliability of the Bible and ask any question regarding the Bible's validity. Joining us to help facilitate discussion were Pastors Abraham Sangha from Christ the King Dorchester and Logan Keck from Christ the King JP/ Roxbury.

Over forty students showed up and got to wrestle with different questions. One Muslim student in attendance asked this question: "If nothing is required for you to have salvation, why would a Christian want to live a righteous lifestyle?" It was a perfect segue for Pastor Keck to share the gospel message and to share Jesus' love that propels us towards righteousness.

The event was a great success in facilitating discussion among students who are not regularly drawn to Cru events on campus. We are planning on putting together two more events like this one in the spring, one at BHCC (which will be a first for this type of event) and another at UMB. Please continue to pray for the seeds planted and for our students to have opportunities to build upon these conversations with the students that came.
