## OVERFLOWING: FALL RETREAT AND MORE!

Fall retreat was a wonderful time for us as well as our students! We were encouraged to bring 20 students from Bunker Hill (BHCC) and 9 from U Mass Boston, record attendance for our schools! Just 3 years ago there were 0 from BHCC! Cru staff Shana Powell and Bob Schwan from Montana spoke at the retreat and challenged our students to go after the gospel, and their respective campuses, wholeheartedly. There were over 300 students (a record) in attendance together worshipping God and wrestling with His call on their lives this year. What a wonderful picture of His kingdom!



Highlights for us included an Echo 2012 summer project reunion dinner, making and receiving dozens of encouragement cards to and from our students, and the annual early morning (optional) prayer time that Jena has led for the past four years. Especially meaningful for one Harvard student was the Sunday morning prayer time where we shared campus concerns with the group of 20+, laid hands on one another and offered our requests to God. She remarked afterwards, "I never knew prayer could be so powerful. I feel so freed up of my burdens at Harvard, I feel free to seek Him without expectations."



## Unprecedented Growth!

We are amazed how much growth has occurred already this year, especially at BHCC. We now have over 60 students involved and 30 of those are freshmen! The new students are all so excited to be part of the ministry that it has breathed new life into the group. We also have added two new life groups at BHCC and now have 4 going strong. Every event we do is bursting at the seams with students. We took students from 5 schools apple picking (see pic below) and we filled 3 school buses and 5 cars!
