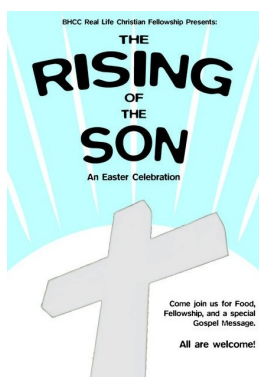

RIISING OF THE SON



A few weeks ago we helped students run an event at Bunker Hill Community College (BHCC) called "Rising of the Son," where we presented the gospel to around 75 students. This type of event is unprecedented at BHCC! We had Bunker hill students as emcees, Jena and another student performed worship songs, and Pastor Dan Rogers of Christ the King Dorchester gave a gospel message.

Afterwards we had the opportunity to follow up with students to better explain the gospel message to them and the importance that Easter plays in our faith.

We are amazed that at a place like BHCC God has risen up a true movement of students that desire to know him more, grow together and tell others about who he is. BHCC is often overlooked and famously seen as the place of failure for Robin Williams' character in *Good Will Hunting*. However, God often uses "the least of these" to remind us that ultimately he is the one in control. Thank God for that!

We have spent the past few weeks with students debriefing the past year while planning strategically for the upcoming fall. We are excited that our student leaders are so eager to serve one another, to walk humbly with God and to seek to give every student the opportunity to hear the gospel and respond to it. Summer Plans

This summer we are excited to have the opportunity to participate in a leadership development course, a seminary level track called "Leadership at Altitude." The course will be for 4 weeks in Fort Collins, CO. After the course is completed we will then have our week long national Campus Crusade Staff Conference with 8,000 other staff from around the country. We will be driving out to Colorado and hope to see some of you

on our way there/back. The dates of our time out there will be approximately June 15th-July 31st.

Our hope is to enter the fall school year with a plan based on our own unique gifts and abilities that is strategic in winning students to Christ, building them up in their faith, and sending them out to be His ambassadors in the world.
