Rohan, one of our students from UMass Boston, attended Epicenter for the first time. With several physical and speech disabilities, Rohan often feels like an outsider in social contexts, but enjoyed the fellowship and new friendships he made as a result of being at the conference. The following is what he shared during our time of debrief:

"I didn't think I could do this conference because I had a disability. I didn't think I would fit in because of my disability. Then in the men's group a young man stood up and said that he didn't feel like he fit in. That made me feel great and I shared more than I thought I could or would. I want to be an inspiration to everyone I meet."

THE EPICENTER EXPERIENCE!

The Epicenter Experience, Cru's winter conference for students from colleges and universities in the northeast, took place over Martin Luther King, Jr. weekend. Epicenter was a wonderful experience for our family as well as our students! We were privileged to bring 36 students from Bunker Hill and UMass Boston which was the most ever we've ever had at the conference. Students spent four days participating in great worship, having fellowship with over 400 other students from around the Northeast and doing things like a "digital faithwave", where they shared their faith through Face-



book, Twitter, texts, emails and phone calls. They heard from speaker Matt Miklatos, author of several books, including *Imaginary Jesus*. A gifted storyteller, Matt challenged our students with modern retelling of such passages as Luke 7:36-50 and charged them to love much, as the woman who poured perfume on Jesus' feet had done. The final session culminated in students signing a pledge to the Lord that they would "Go where you want me to go, do what you want me to do, give what you want me to give, and say what you want me to say." It was a powerful evening of surrender and many of our students signed the pledge!
