




## BOSTON ECHO

We'll let Nelson take it from here:

*"From the moment I got to the conference I'll admit that I was in complete awe, **seeing everyone with such a passion for Christ.** For the entire week I felt confused about the whole thing. On the last night I randomly had a conversation with another student. We talked about Christ and if I was ready to accept Him. I said yes because I really did feel like I was ready to accept Him into my life. After I prayed, it felt like right away that He was working in me and I felt this joy which I've never really felt before."*

Isn't it awesome how God *randomly* sent this student to share with Nelson at the point when he was ready to accept him into his life? Maybe not so random! Another student from BHCC, Amanda, was trained to share the gospel at the conference. When she returned home she shared it with her mother and she accepted Christ! Amazing!
