A January Update from the Carsons!

Fastbreak 2024

At our winter conference, I had the honor of being the emcee as well as the director of young men's seminar. On the top right, you'll also see my 14 boys from Fountain Valley and Garden Grove. At the end of the day, we would sit in our cabins and reflect on what God had taught us that day.

On the second night, we talked about the idea of being "fully known & fully loved". The idea is that we can often hide our sin and shortcomings from others because we are afraid. The first student said, "I have a secret that I've never told anyone... I feel weird and alone for saying this, but I watch porn online and I don't know how to stop." Another guy shared, "Me too! It didn't bother me before, but after I became a Christian in Cru, it feels so much worse! Is that the Holy Spirit talking to me?" Knowing that they weren't alone and that they are loved in their sin, was a powerful realization for them. Sin thrives in the darkness, but shrivels in the Light!







Prayer Requests

- Pray for my boys in their battle to be satisfied in God alone. While it's wonderful that they are experiencing being fully known and fully loved, the next step is to help them learn to combat the lies of the enemy. Just like the original lie in the garden, satan wants us to believe that God isn't good and doesn't love us.
- Pray that they would seek and believe truth... that Jesus is good... and that He is worth it!





Guys Time

On Sunday, our 364 students separated into guys and girls time. When I prayed over the preparation of the time, I felt God asking me to speak sexual purity. I started by giving students a ten-question survey. After collecting the responses anonymously, I randomly redistributed them. Then, I had participants stand if their survey indicated a 'yes' for the first question, providing real-time statistics from the room.

For the question 'Do you often feel lonely or unloved?', 70% stood up. Regarding the definition of shame – feeling unwanted or unworthy of belonging – only 10 remained seated. As for 'Have you watched pornography?', all but 5 were standing. And almost the entirety of the room believed that their sexual sin would go away once they were happily married to a Godly woman. Clearly the Lord had lead us to speak on a needed topic! Sexual sin often stems from shame and dissatisfaction with God. Many boys turn to porn as a coping mechanism without recognizing it, stemming from deep emotional repression. To address this, I led them in an emotional awareness exercise to help them better understand and navigate their feelings. One student shared: 'I used to think I turned to porn out of boredom, but now, as a Christian, I realize my guilt is heavier. The exercise revealed feelings of loneliness, a desire for a girlfriend, and stress about the future. Porn never healed these; how do I let Jesus heal this?' I was encouraged to see that he understood the first step! Pray as we lead them to Jesus in this journey.
