### **Youssef Girgis**

Youssef, invited to Cru by his old sister, was always a quiet but involved student. Now a senior, he felt called to share his testimony from the stage. Here is his story!

"I was born into an amazing Christian family in Egypt where I had all that I needed. The highlight of my year was my birthday as everyone came together to celebrate! Then my parents enrolled in the Egyptian lottery to win papers to move to America. They won. Before I knew it, I lost my home and was thrown into a foreign country. Struggling to find work, my dad took employment wherever he could. This led to us moving 8 times across 2 counties and two states... in one year. This, combined with my parents constantly fighting, destroyed my sense of stability and peace. One low moment was my 10th birthday. It was

my parents, our landlord, and a cake. The candles went out and the party was over. Missing my friends and family, I realized that I was truly alone and life felt meaningless.

Thankfully, it didn't end there! My sister and my parents soon got me involved in a local church as well as Cru. These both changed my life! I realized that God never left me, and that He LOVES me. I became active in attending meetings and conferences where I grew in my faith. After this, I met my friend Daniel through an online video game. He shared about how struggled to believe that his life mattered due to the conflict in his life such as poverty and his parents fighting. Having gone through a similar thing, I was excited to share my story and how God helped me through the darkest of times! Over an internet call, I was able to also share my faith and lead him in the prayer to receive Jesus! It was incredible to see that I am not too broken for God to use me!"

### **Saturday Evangelism**

On Saturday, Jessica was in charge of sending 44 staff and 103 students to Huntington Beach to share the good news of Jesus! After setting up a booth for "Prayers and Popsicles" and another for testimonies, the police showed up. Someone had called them and reported us for giving free drinks away which requires a permit. Thankfully, Jessica quickly changed plans and sent out students in groups with the snacks! We approached 135 people, shared the Gospel with 25, and 11 said yes to pray to receive Jesus! Many students left with a joy and hunger to share more!
