When I was at MTL (Missional Team Leader) training this summer in Colorado, Roger Hershey said something similar. Hershey, who has served on staff with Cru for over 35 years and has led some of the largest movements in Cru's history, shared that he is still on campus, even well into his 60's because he knows of no better place for raising up laborers.

This year as we pray and dream for the future, we're excited for the student leaders that we are developing. Whether they choose to enter into full time ministry after school or be strategic leaders for the gospel in their churches and communities, we know that we're on the right track to sending as many laborers into the missions field as we possibly can. One of the major shifts in our ministry this past year was to give greater ownership of the mission to students leaders. While many of our students are young leaders, they are full of energy and love for the Lord. As we coach and equip our nearly 50 student leaders, they have set a faith goal of befriending over 300 freshmen and having over 300 gospel conversations this semester.

We are very encouraged as students led the annual lunch line surveys where we saw 800 students fill out surveys with 275 wanting information about our ministry or to hear the gospel. We've also seen record numbers of students at all our launch events (rootbeer keg party, Boba Tea Night). In all we have over 500 student to follow up with.

Please pray for our students in the next weeks as they share the gospel actively and start their small group Bible studies and pray for us to have great wisdom and love as we coach and equip our student leaders.
