For the past three weeks I have been in Daytona, finishing up my New Staff Training. I've been taking two seminary classes, Intro to Christian Theology and Bible Study Methods. We've had a ton of homework, and I feel like I have really been learning how to become a better minister of the Gospel of Christ. Mixed in with our teaching has been plenty of evangelism here.
