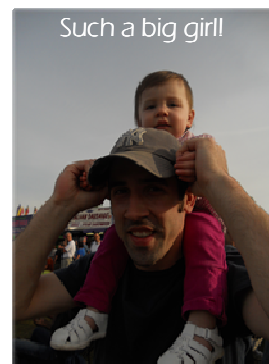
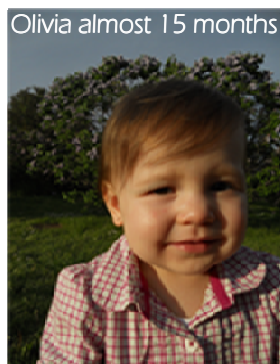
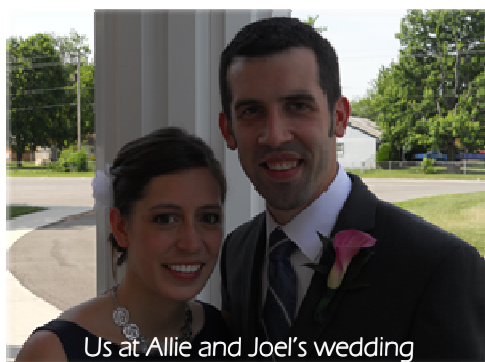
Building Spiritual Movements Everywhere
