

COW CAKE LADY

I chatted with her while she made fire cakes from the cow manure that she used to cook her family's meals.

Using her feet, she mixed in straw, and added enough water to form cakes with her hands. Then, with a loud 'Whop', she slapped the cakes up against the side of her hut to dry.

This lady represents the millions of people from unreached people groups who have yet to hear the gospel of Christ taught in their own language. People who have lived for generations, trapped in a world religion mixed with ancestral animistic beliefs and raised in a social hierarchy that cannot be broached.

How will she ever hear of the truth that can bring light into her dark world? And of a Creator God who loved her enough to lay down His life that she might have eternal life?

Is there a way she could hear in her own language, the foundational Truths of the Bible? And if she could hear and believe, how can she grow in a society that would make her more of an outcast than she already is?

Mid October I travel to South Asia with Ethnos360 CEO, Larry Brown, my pastor, John Parker and two businessmen. Our travel will take us to the birthplace of three of the world's largest religions, Hinduism, Buddhism and Islam. We will look intently at the cultural and religious impact on the people who live there, asking ourselves this question.

How can Ethnos360 whose expertise of planting thriving churches across cultural barriers among tribal peoples help reach the ethnic people groups in South Asia?
