Hurricane Matthew

On October 4th, Hurricane Matthew devastated Haiti's southern peninsula.

As Hurricane Matthew barreled its way through the Caribbean and up the southeastern United States, it left a wake of misery and devastation behind. While we were able to brave the storm in Florida with minimal damage and no loss



of power, impoverished Haiti was much less equipped to handle the brunt of the storm. Texts, phone calls, e-mails and Facebook messages flooded in, asking if everyone at Open Door was safe and what could be done to help.



Orphanage Update

While some of our seventeen churches throughout Haiti were hit harder than others, we're extremely grateful that our orphanage with its 50 beautiful children faired well through the storm.

Our relief efforts are focused on providing support to our churches in harder hit areas where there was damage to homes, churches and schools, as well as severe crop damage and the loss of livestock. We've raised the initial funds to send a container with 300,000 meals for Open Door's churches to distribute to those in greatest need.

We have three teams in Haiti between now and the end of the year, and we will also send extra medical supplies, clothes,



toiletries and food on another container in December.

CHURCH PLANTING When we started Open Door Haiti in the US to support the work of Open Door Church and Pastor Wiljean in Haiti ten years ago, Open Door had only two churches. Today there are seventeen. Each new church that is planted is given the vision of multiplying. This Summer, Open Door sent teams to plant churches in two new locations... Fort Liberty and Hinche.

TRAINING IMPACT SOYM began in 2008 with a vision of raising up the next generation of young leaders in Haiti. Over the last 9 vears, we've trained over 100 men and women in disciplemaking. SOYM's young leaders are serving in our churches as pastors and youth pastors. They're leading our medical clinic, orphanage and agriculture programs. They are making a huge difference!

ORPHANAGE



OUR KIDS Our orphanage opened in December 2011, becoming the home to 25 beautiful children. One year ago, we completed our boys wing, doubling our capacity. Overnight, our needs doubled! We now had 50 children to care for. We had to double our staff, double our budget. With the generous help of a partner church and a foundation, we were able to meet that need for the past year. We're now in need of more Orphan Sponsors for these amazing children.

MEDICAL CLINIC

SCHOOLS/FEEDING CENTERS



CLINIC EXPANSION Our clinic has seen much growth over the past 10 years. We began with a part-time doctor and two nurses. Today, we have two full-time doctors in addition to that part-time doctor, plus several nurses, a pharmacy, a lab and ambulance service.. This year, we've opened a second floor to the clinic that houses our labor and delivery unit as well as a dental clinic. The government has been so impressed with our work, they've asked for the clinic to be staffed 24 hours a day.



NEW SCHOOLS With each new church plant, there is the potential of a new school opening. Almost half our churches have schools to meet the educational needs of the rural communities they serve. We've started 3 new schools in 2016. With the help of Feeding Children Everywhere, we're able to feed these kids each day at school!

Our primary focus has been on getting all our orphans sponsored, but the need continues to grow for child sponsors.
