
HAPPY THANKSGIVING

Devastating Floods



One month after Hurricane Matthew devastated much of Haiti, torrential rains brought more flooding. Our church in Cap Haiti was flooded, destroying instruments and sound equipment. Our entire ministry compound in Bois De Lance was under 1-2 feet of water, which almost filled our mission house and flooded the first floor of our school. Pastor Donnson lost all the furniture in his home, as well as his motorcycle. I would like to raise \$1000 to replace his motorcycle. It's heartbreaking to see my friends suffer like this.

School of Youth Ministry



Our training program for young leaders in Haiti, SOYM, brings together students from across Haiti for 10 months of intensive disciple-making and leadership development. DHM needs to raise about \$10,000 each year to support this training program... \$500 per student to scholarship them for the training they will receive. Would you consider providing a scholarship for one of these young leaders? God is using them to transform Haiti... one life at a time!

Leadership Development



Our Sonlife Leadership Team is spread across North America... Orlando, DC, Toronto, Chicago, Portland, Cleveland, Seattle, Wichita. While I'm in Florida, our administrative offices are on the opposite corner of the country in Portland. I would love to have 1-2 interns here in Orlando to help me with both Sonlife and Open Door Haiti projects. These part-time internships would be ideal for local college students who could serve 10-12 hours a week. \$500 a month per intern needs to be raised to make this a reality.

Caring for Kids



ORPHANAGE - Open Door Haiti's orphanage is the home to fifty beautiful children. What a gift from God they are! We need of monthly sponsors for the orphanage. A full sponsorship is \$150 a month, but you can share the sponsorship burden with others for as little as \$25 or \$50 a month.

SCHOOL - Open Door Haiti's schools continue to expand. We have over 1000 children in our sponsorship program, but less than 300 of them have sponsors right now. A Child Sponsorship is only **\$25** a month.
