

THE MASAI LION SPIKE

A weapon used by the Masai tribe when hunting a lion. One brave Masai warrior "runs to the roar." While all the warriors encircle the lion with their spears, one of them charges the lion, and when he roars, ready to attack, the Masai thrusts the lion spike in his mouth, where his jaws are then impaled on the spike. The lion cannot bite down, allowing the other warriors to pounce on and kill the lion with their spears.

RUN TO THE ROAR!

Shortly before our family's Kenya adoption adventure in 2005, I had heard Erwin McMannus speak and then read his book, *The Barbarian Way*. The book was a challenge to abandon the "play it safe" mentality and live with bold faith. McMannus gave the example of the rhino, an animal that can run at speeds up to 30 miles per hour, but can only see 30 feet in front of it's nose. But to the rhino, that doesn't matter. It will charge anyway. That's why a group

of rhinos is not called a herd, but rather a CRASH. McMannus' words emboldened us to abandon the easy road, move to Kenya, and bring Mary-Faith home.

A few years later, I read Mark Batterson's book, *In A Pit with a Lion on a Snowy Day*, which tells the story of Benaaiah from 2 Samuel 23. Benaiah was one of King David's Mighty Men, became captain of his body guard, and eventually was made commander of the armies of Israel by David's son, King Solomon. One of Benaiah's exploits was chasing a lion into a pit

on a snowy day and killing it! Benaiah didn't run from the roar, He ran to it!

I was challenged to live with a fearless faith, a willingness to dream big and take risks for God. We started Open Door Haiti, built a medical clinic and an orphanage, adopted two more daughters, and stepped into a larger leadership role with Sonlife.

In 2013, I ran into Mark Batterson at a conference and told him I wanted to send him a special gift... a Lion Spike... as a symbol of courageous faith!

From 2003 to 2013, we made about 80 trips globally to inspire, instruct and involve disciple-makers...

Now that I'm privileged to lead Sonlife North America, our global efforts have shifted to collaborating on an organizational level with Sonlife's global partners where we strategize for continent-wide impact.

GYI Leadership Forum In March, our Sonlife leadership

team was able to join leaders from almost 30 countries for the GYI Forum in Czech. We strategized together on building strong disciple-making

movements and studied the history of the Moravian

Movement on location in Czech, Poland and Germany.

J-Life East Africa Forum After having launched and led J-Life Africa's efforts in East Africa from 2005-2010, expanding our training efforts from Kenya to Uganda, Rwanda, Tanzania, Burundi and Zanzibar, it was an incredible privilege to invest in these leaders once again at the East Africa Forum in April. We had 25 leaders from 8 African nations gather for the week, including South Sudan and DRC.
