- Fruitful ten-week home assignment, visiting 15 churches and 20 individual supporters. Saw John's 94year-old father and our son Yutaka, his wife Amy and our three-year-old grandsons, Oscar and Arlo.
- Helped staff Church Planting Institute's (CPI) Consulting Center late in October in Saitama. Eleven of us met with 100 clients. I personally met with 14 front line workers. Church Planting Institute last month through coaching and training, was a great joy. Attending the 20th anniversary of Saikyo Hope Chapel, where Joshua Hari is pastor, and a church



we planted in 1997, was so encouraging to Eriko and me.

Over these past 20 years, 58 people have trusted in Christ and were baptized, and the church is planting three house churches.

Hokushin Calvary Church in Fukushima city, is planting as well. They are planting a church as we shared in August, but they are also planting the gospel in the hearts of the next generation. They are building a multi-purpose sports court on their property to impact the youth of their community. We have set up a Muti-Purpose Sports Court Special Project to help fund this. Please e-mail us if you would like to see the promotional video. Hokushin is a thriving church with over 20% of its 70 attendees under twenty years of age. It is the largest church in Fukushima City, with a population of over 300,000. The youth make lunch once a month to help raise funds for this.
