Lakewood High School ~ Every Friday for the last few months we've been holding lunch meetings at Lakewood. We've been having anywhere from 80-120 students each week come for pizza and a short message in the gym. Honestly, at first I asked myself if it was worth spending the money each week on pizzas for 100+ kids to come, when (in my mind) they were just there for free food... most of them were talking, on their phones, or simply not listening. Just this last week, a girl came up to me after and asked me how to biblically navigate grief because she didn't want to resort back to self harm. She had tears in her eyes and the Lord kindly reminded me that it is worth it. Continue to pray that I would be able to meet with her and that we would be able to start an after school bible study starting in the new year.
