COMPASSION

A lady from the village hobbled towards our camp with her husband. As she lifted her shirt, we could see that she suffered severe burns down the entire right side of her body. Our medical team began to uncover the damage and found that the wounds exceeded our capabilities. The team did all they could medically and shared the peace of Christ with the couple. Nearby a group of believers met for discipleship. By divine appointment, Randy had decided to share on the story of the Good Samaritan. As he shared and discussed how the church should respond to the needs of the hurting around them, he turned to see the woman who had come and called the church to be the "good Samaritan". Out of their nothingness, the church pulled their resources to get the woman the treatment she needed. Overwhelmed by Christ's story and the love she had experienced, she and her husband gave their life to Christ.

DISCIPLESHIP

As we ventured to the outskirts of the village we stumbled upon the house of a passionate believer. Norbert's smile lit the courtyard as he poured out his joy. He told us the story of how he rode his bicycle all through out the village proclaiming his faith. Without a bible, without a pastor or a church building, he got it. He was no theologian, but he understood the purpose of our creation; to know Christ and to make him known. Norbert's only source of strength and wisdom came from pouring his heart out and listening to the King in the stillness of his garden.

EVANGELISM

Sitting in the shade of one family's courtyard we went through the greetings and customs. As we led into a time for sharing the gospel stories one of our Malian team members jumped in to tell the gospel story. He picked up a stick just like he had seen us do so many times. In his broken English he said "No problem I the story master." He proceeded to paint a vivid picture of the gospel with his words, his sincerity and his faithful stick for drawing in the dirt.

After seeing The Hope film a young teen committed to the gospel. As an act of friendship he offered to perform a traditional tribal dance with his friends. Before the performance the boy shared his new faith with the other dancers and they also believed and accepted. After the incredible performance the boys shared that they are preparing a dance that will share the gospel. God granted us the sweet mercy of seeing the hope for Mali's church.



Norbert had a hunger for fellowship and for access to the gospel. Our indigenous disciplers, Barnabas and Chiekna spent an entire day with Norbert teaching him the principles of church formation and spiritual growth. The next day I had the honor of giving Norbert a solar radio that continuously plays the Gospel. He held that radio like his most treasured belonging and passion burned in his eyes as the radio began to share the knowledge he desired.

PRAYER

To begin our journey the team spent 24 hours in prayer. These are some of our prayers: May our team be unified in Christ with one heart and one purpose - May we have the attitude of Christ - Holy Spirit flood our temples and be a beacon in the darkness that pierces the very souls of the beautiful Malians - May we as a team make your son's sacrifice relevant to the world - May your power and promises sound as drums of truth - Let their hearts sing a new song - May this town become a revival of God's people - Come, Lord Jesus, Come...Amina!

The Lord was faithful to answer all our humble prayers.
