Ministry Update

A dear friend from college and I met for lunch back in February. Jody, the assistant student ministries director for North Point church, shared her deep desire for her students to know about great commission work. North Point is a local church that does a phenomenal job reaching their neighbors, but Jody knew that some of her students would be called to overseas missions. We shared a desire for students to understand God's heart for all people, local and abroad. This lunchtime discussion evolved into a day of service and learning for 184 middle and high school students. The students learned about the plight of the unreached, how they could be a part of God's mission, and then took action by interceding for the nations on our prayer trail. Sharing my heart and raising awareness on behalf of the unreached fulfilled my heart in the deepest way. They were an incredible group of youth who served in the heat without complaint and listened with an open heart to the Gospel.

There are 690,000 international students currently studying in the US. Of those students a vast majority are not Christian and many come from unreached or restricted nations. The Lord brings the nations to our doorstep every year. These are the future leaders and bright minds of their countries and what an opportunity to introduce them to the Ruler above all. Unfortunately 75% of these students will never enter an American home according to International Students Inc. Students from all over the world move right into our backyard, they are hungry for truth and they are starving for community.
