My joy, in that realization, came not from the fact that the lessons had served their purpose, but in the fact that this clear message was prepared for a ripe harvest among the unreached. My joy expounded when I saw the team on the field. Young deaf students and deaf adults received the message, and we saw a harvest. School to the Nations believes firmly in well-trained students who are prepared physically, mentally and most of all spiritually to face the hard battles that come at the ends of the earth. Through my ministry at School to the Nations, I have the opportunity to go to foreign fields, but my job also allows me to train and move multiple teams to places all over the world and I am privileged to be a part of teaching and rising up future missionaries

I am so thankful for all who have been supporting me in prayer and financially. I started with the mindset that support raising was the Lord's plan for my provision as I served in ministry. Yet now I see it is God's beautiful plan for all believers to join His mission by fulfilling their calling. It requires the body of Christ to join, intertwine and invest in one another, so that peoples may know His name. God pens a masterpiece of His flock obeying their shepherd and His peace reaching the ends of the Earth (Micah 5:4). The students I train and the places I go are not my work...they are a beautiful masterpiece of God's church obeying His commands. Together we share in the harvest


