Dear Friends, this year I landed in Mali West Africa for the third time and headed onto the sandy soil with confidence in my preparation, my knowledge, my calling and my packing skills. After watching the conveyor belt of luggage spin for nearly an hour I realized that all of my work and prep sat in a dusty airport storage room. With few ministry tools, a little bit of food and the clothes on my back I set out on what would be a season of complete reliance on the Lord. Without the comforts of home I came to an understanding of the simplicity of Christ's calling and the power and provision of His love.

Through the fragrant love of Christ, the natives came and ate of truth out of their hunger pains for their Creator. Over the last three years the believers in this tribe have grown from 3 to over 300. With the revival in Africa ringing in my ears, I left for India where I was again faced with the lost and hurting world. Upon coming home I realized more than ever the need to act for the Gospel, therefore the Lord has landed me here at School to the Nations as a missions mobilizer. I get the great honor of training, preparing and sending teams that go into the darkest places of the World with the Light of truth.



It is not the large numbers or missionary hype that have motivated me to be here; it is seeing one Fulanke woman find hope in the struggle, one Hindu woman turning from the painted god on the wall to worship the living God and it is realizing that there are millions more around the world waiting for this same hope. I sit on the frontline of frontier missions eager to be a part of people from all nations, tribes and tongues singing to the Lord like is promised in Revelations 5:9. Through my ministry at School to the Nations, I get the great privilege of going, but my job also allows me to train and move multiple teams to places all over the world.

I am so blessed and thankful for all of you who have already partnered with me through prayer and finances. I pray that you know the power of your gift and the beauty of your movement for the Gospel. In order to be able to continue in full time ministry I am in need of people to partner with me financially.
