

From my heart...

This January I entered my 19th country. The landscape was more lush than I had ever seen, but the people were barren of hope. The kind mountain people had a smile on their face, but emptiness in their soul. They were held captive by an unending circle of trying to please the spirits and restricted by the communist control that dictated their lifestyle. I wanted to stop the van in every village and share His story, but that would be just like me trying to ride a bull...I would be bucked out of the country and left with damaged parts of what could have been a fervent ministry.

As I rode through the mountains with my broken heart and weepy eyes, I asked the Lord, "Where do we even start?"

He replied in His gentle and kind way, "Right here, my broken child, right here in my presence."

Sometimes in our human attempts to evangelize the world we overshoot the place where God always starts big things: a humble posture before His throne. In Mark chapter 1 Jesus begins his ministry by meeting, loving and healing the nearby people. Then we see Jesus go to a place of solitary prayer and only after that does he go out to preach; yet somehow we so often try to shortcut this step and actually "do something".

So often we are willing to go build churches or lead big crusades, but are we also willing to travel to distant lands to pray and intercede on behalf of one of God's precious children? God took me half way around the world, He let me intertwine with another people and He broke my heart to lead me to authentic intercession. With this new commitment to start a church planting movement among these S.E. Asia people, we desire to start in the same place Jesus did.
