He says that the gospel is going out even more while he is locked up. This time of limited movement, though not prison, is also opening new avenues to reach people with the gospel. The daily listenership and interactions on the web have both gone up, and people are searching for a message of hope.

Virtual conferences are another new venture for HCJB. Our in-person events tended to get over 1000 people attending, and our first two virtual conferences averaged over 30,000 people each. This is something we want to continue to offer into the future, even after going back to conferences in person.

Physical and financial needs continue for many in Ecuador. HCJB has been able to help through food distribution, working with local churches and other local ministries. The need is overwhelming since so many live day to day.
