## October Conferences

In mid-October, HCJB hosted two conferences for women; one in Quito, Ecuador, and one in Ambato, Ecuador. A total of 1600 people came, and it was a sell out crowd in both places. The conference speakers shared from their own experiences about sexuality, living with a positive outlook, and how to overcome and forgive abuse from the past.
