Dear Pastor,

I am writing today from San Jose, Costa Rica. I am here to help Missionary Bob Martin. We just completed this season's Bible Institute in Cortez. Four students graduated. Three of them are pastors and one of them is going to be a missionary to Panama. Brother Martin and his wife are doing a great work with these men in helping them understand the principles and doctrines in the Word of God. There was a woman saved in the mid week service and a young man was saved on Saturday at the Graduation service. It was my privilege to visit Missionaries Joshua and Erika Prince here as well. They are in language school preparing to go to Uruguay. Since our last letter we have preached at several churches in Texas and Oklahoma. August 26, 30, and 31, we will be helping Pastor Dick Webster conduct the annual deputation school in Lewisville, Texas. This year we will host six or seven new missionary couples who are making plans to go to the mission field. It is an exciting time for us. After deputation school, I will fly to Seattle to attend the national GIBF meeting in Everett, WA. I will preach in three churches in the area. We will then introduce several new missionaries to the Fellowship and recommend them to the churches. In early October, my wife and I will be on the road again. We covet your prayers as we travel. I will be driving to Philadelphia to preach a week-long missions' revival at Christ Independent Baptist Church. My wife will meet me there after she has spoken at the annual ladies meeting at Open Door Baptist Church, Astoria, NY, and made a visit to her mother in Virginia. We will then travel by car to the Northeast where we will be involved in several missions' conferences and fellowship meetings.
