Five times in 2 Corinthians chapter eight, Paul uses the terms, "throughout all the churches," "messengers of the churches," and "before the churches". By using these terms, Paul illustrates the need for cooperation among the churches in raising funds and helping others. In the New Testament; it is churches helping churches. This is the pattern of the churches who affiliate with the GIBF.

Principles That Make us Distinctive

- 1. The GIBF makes no distinction in business meetings among pastors, missionaries, and evangelists.
- 2. GIBMissions makes no distinction between home and foreign missions.
- *3. GIBMissions does not operate as an alumni association.*
