Praise the Lord! Summer is here! Wow, get ready for the heat! Ninety degrees with a humidity of ninety as well. Brethren, first let me say your prayers and petitions are truly appreciated for us here in our new home and field of souls and we love you dearly in the Lord. November 25th was our arrival and it has been such a great journey of winning souls to the Lord. We have been in Cagayan de Oro city now for four months and been experiencing what you would call a heat wave. The breeze has been nice here, even though every time you here about Mindanao it's Hot and I mean the next thing to Africa – desert heat. Well, we got over the New Year and had the chance to light fireworks, They have this here like it's their Fourth of July. So I bought some and the family enjoyed it much. Can you believe it is already the middle of March; time for the Lord to come back it makes you think, right? Coming soon to a cloud near you! Wow I'm excited. Surely the time is passing quickly. Even so, come Lord Jesus and get us out of this mess, as one preacher quoted and you ask the Lord why you taking so long LOL. His ways and plans will never be ours.

For the first time here in this part the region we have had our "flash flood". You talk about water flowing everywhere; what an experience. It took us about four days to evacuate the water, but we did it by the grace of the Lord. One of the major problems here is that everything is done a lot slower, and I mean everything. Our neighbors never bought proper drainage materials so that causes a major overflow, and we happen to be at this time at a low land level, so I'll leave the rest to you to think about. Rain has been a major factor here in this city. Sometimes you can have a good attitude about it; other times not really. Major work ahead.

Great things have been happening for us as far as ministry here in our city. I will be starting to teach in Mindanao Evangelistic Institute soon; what a blessing to be with the staff and their lives. There are now at least three outreaches that we conduct – me and my brother-in-law as he is in continual training with me. He is a blessing! W is planning to get into a campus ministry as well. This will be a challenge as we go into these places. At the same time, open air preaching is starting now with banners and scripture signs that are made here for three U.S dollars; how bout that? Not bad. We are trying to get other materials as well and get it blown up and use it to bring the "lost at any cost." I cannot tell you of all the blessings and open doors we have here. We have opportunities to visit three parts of the southern Philippines where the religion of Islam is predominant. Now that is just a pass-through with some nationals who are doing what I can't in these places. The island of Mindanao is a HUGE Mission Field and very few churches are going out and launching out by faith. I believe that's why we are here – to help them to get off the couch, or the hardwood bamboo we would say, and get ready! He's coming. Got to live right so we can leave right.
