Of those students, 14 indicated a decision to surrender their lives to Christ, 64 wanted some kind of followup conversation, and over 100 received articles with more info and resources about sexual addiction.

It was definitely an issue on campus, so thanks so much for your prayers!

One freshman girl said she realized she was already living a sexual addicted lifestyle, and was so thankful for Michael and the event. We have been able to offer follow-up Bible studies for her and the others who wanted to find out more about what the Bible says about healthy relationships.

---Additionally, our JJ Heller concert was also a great success. This concert was to promote World Vision's efforts to fight human trafficking. We partnered with a local Chick-fil-A [always good when that happens] and had 300+ students attend and receive free chicken sandwiches.

A number of students sponsored children and were given info on ways to advocate and get involved with stopping human trafficking.

---Both of these events were great as it gave our students some vision and focus to changing the culture on campus. If you don't remember, just last year, SDSU was voted 'Most Degenerate Student Body' by Radaronline.com, so it has been great to partner with the campus to change that image. SDSU itself gave over \$4500 for us to pull off these two events, the most I've EVER seen a campus give to events we've done.
