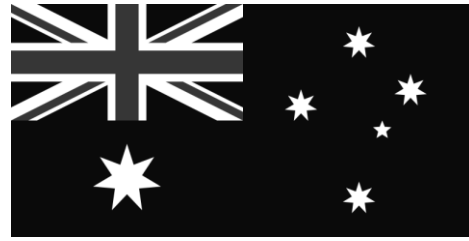

Aussie Info

Some people have misconceptions that Australia is just a vacation destination to swim, see kangaroos or barbeque shrimp. We wanted to bring you all into the loop on why we've been partnering in ministry with universities in Australia for over a decade.

--Australia has a total population of about 21 million people with about 90% of the population living within an hour of the coast.

--About 55% of the population claim to be Christian but only 10% attend a religious service per week. --The numbers do not include people in younger generations. Only about 1-2% of college students have had any kind of church background.
