One of these students, whom we'll call Cody, agreed to meet with Clay and a Cru student leader named Erik. They sat outside the (unfortunately full) campus coffee shop in the heat, as Clay gently asked about his spiritual background. Cody said he had been raised in the church, but left as a teen when he got fed up with what he described as "stereotypical Christianity." As they talked further, it was clear that despite his background, Cody's heart was open.

"Before [I left the church] I had an easy time trusting people. I want to trust people again, and I want to trust God." Cody admitted.

Clay and Erik were able to share the gospel with Cody. He wasn't ready to trust Christ yet, but agreed to continue coming to Bible study and our weekly meeting, and continuing to consider trusting his life to Christ.

We praise God for the hundreds of students like Cody who have open and ready hearts, just waiting for someone to share the gospel with them.
