the prayers of our team, and the prayers of our students. We have so much to praise God for as a ministry here in Southeast Ohio. The number of students we have been able to reach collectively is smaller, but there is still so much to thank God for!

- Due to a lack of organized campus activities and cancellation of fall sports programs, our team's ministry has seen significant growth at Marietta, with as many as 40 students attending a bible study!
- Overall, as a team we are connecting regularly with around 200 students and faculty on all of our campuses.
- I've had the privilege of leading an action group with students who are home over Zoom, coaching a volunteer with our ministry, and engaging in discipleship with three men (two in-person).
- We are able to safely have a one day Fall Conference on Saturday, October 17 and already have 50 students registered!
- No one on our team has gotten ill from COVID and none of our students have become severely ill from the virus.
