"So, why would you say you three have chosen to be Christians? Is it something you've grown up believing or is it a choice you made later on?"

This is the question that was posed to Reilly, Andria, and me (Clay) as we engaged in conversation with \*Adesh. He is currently an engineering student at the Illinois Institute of Technology (IIT) in Chicago. He grew up in India and shared about his Hindu background.

As we continued talking, Adesh acknowledged that he isn't deeply religious, but that he does desire to open himself up to learning more deeply about other faiths. When asked what he knew about Christianity, he talked generally about the idea being good to avoid bad things in the



afterlife. He also mentioned he didn't really know any Christians.

**He then asked why we are Christians**. Realizing that this might be the first time he has ever had followers of Christ speak into his life, we each took turns sharing with him why we believe in Jesus. We all had the opportunity to share brief versions of our personal testimonies, emphasizing the importance of having a personal relationship with Jesus. It felt very clear that, without speaking to one another, the Spirit was leading each of us to share about how Jesus is a personal God who pursues each of us, so that we might "have life and have it abundantly." (John 10:10)

We had many of these kinds of conversations this summer! We praise God that many have gotten to hear that gospel and that many of our students engaged in these conversations with others for the first time!
