During their second meeting, they shared the story of the ten lepers in Luke 17, when Jesus healed all ten of them but only one of them, a Samaritan, came back and fell before Jesus to thank him and praise God. Jesus then asked where the other nine were and told the one to stand up and go on his way as his faith had made him well. After hearing this story, Matej said, "I want to be like the one who came back. It seems like I should go and get the other nine and tell them to come back too!"

Matej has been sharing the stories from the Bible that he has been reading with Justin and Jay. Unfortunately, the friends he had been sharing with didn't seem too interested in these stories and Matej was beginning to feel discouraged. But just last week Matej found a friend who was open to reading the Bible and curious about how it might apply to his life. Matej and his friend committed to trying to find others who could read the Bible with them.
