<u>Malissa</u> was leading Cru's campus ministry in Chicago. She discerned that many of her students were graduating from college and struggling to find their footing. Life in the real world is much different than college and many people who had dynamic walks with the Lord as students were falling away upon leaving school. So, Malissa joined City to pioneer our Millennial gate in Chicago, where she works with recent grads helping them navigate how to balance work and faith and make an impact where God has planted them. Her ministry is growing and God is bringing staff to join her.

<u>Christy</u> led a Cru team in the United Kingdom before returning to the US last year. While in the UK, she interacted with many refugees from around the world and developed a heart for serving this vulnerable group. Providentially, Christy's home church in the Cleveland area learned that a number of refugees are being settled in the Cleveland area and they desired to use their financial and people resources to serve these people. They asked Christy if she would consider partnering with them, helping them to launch this ministry, while serving with Cru City. She has been at work in Cleveland for several months now and God is opening all sorts of doors.

These are just a few of the people that I have helped join City this year. Sometimes my job feels a bit removed and not "real ministry"; however, without people doing my job, it would be impossible for Cru to get people to the field.
