"From the moment I came to Mizzou, God has had such an amazing plan that He has been orchestrating and leading... My purpose hasn't been to run races, to get PR's, or earn athletic awards. My purpose has been to run the race that brings me closer to Jesus and to show others how great He is... As a freshman when everything was going wrong, I thought I had lost my identity because I couldn't run, but later I thankfully realized that my identity was not in running, but it was that I am a child of God and that is all that matters. I am so thankful for all the sadness and hurt I have endured in recent years because if not for those things, I would not have the faith that I do today."

Wow! These are some of Sarah's words in a Facebook post as she shared that her upcoming first collegiate race, would also end up being her last collegiate race too. Sarah is a Junior on the Mizzou track team and has been plagued by hip injuries throughout her career. This is what has lead her to trust God when His plan was so incredibly different than her plan. In the process, she has depended on Him and been His instrument in more ways than you can imagine. He has opened up conversations with other injured athletes as Sarah has done her physical therapy and rehab with people she couldn't have connected with if she had not been injured. He has given her a platform of persevering and trusting, which has been impacting MANY around her.
