This site is an important part of our short wave ministry and many lives will be touched by the signals that are broadcast from FEBC's transmitters in Iba. We will continue in Iba through the end of June and then make a trip back to Jakarta to visit our home in Lippo for the month of July.

At the end of July we will be joining with our International Office missionary staff in Singapore for a retreat. We are joining the retreat since Guy will be joining the IO. Guy's boss Luke will take over as interim manager of the IO and Guy will be absorbed into the group. We all relish your prayers for this meeting. There is always turbulence in times of change and working for the Lord does not confer immunity. If anything the evil one takes the opportunity of change to stir up discord and to mess up relationships. Pray

that a clear direction and consensus will emerge for the next year and that the Lord will display his power and leadership of FEBC.

We want to take this opportunity to say thank you to all of our financial partners. We mentioned in previous updates that this year would be an expensive year for us and many people responded with extra gifts that have equaled our extra expenses. For the last three months almost all of Guy's time has been spent in managing the Iba Renovation Project. Even during our time outside the Philippines he keeps up on what is going on with the project. Communication with people in Iba can be difficult since internet, electrical power and even telephone can all be interrupted from time to time. We have had struggles with connectivity during typhoons which are common this time of year in the Philippines. Besides international travel we are all getting familiar with the bus. Many of our contractors on the project come from Manila. Each bidding and contract can require a trip back to the city for discussions, negotiations, or for closing the deal.

In his "spare" time Guy continues to monitor the technical progress at the new stations he helped to build in Indonesia. During our stay back home in Lippo in July he is looking forward to making a trip to Sulewasi to see the new Nautel transmitter that was installed in Makassar. Guy provided technical advice and assitance with the transmitter purchase. The transmitter was late in shipping from the factory so it was installed by the local

broadcast engineer. Guy didn't get the chance to inspect the installation. He is also working on finalizing a new antenna for the station so that it can cover all of the intended audience.

Iba Renovation Project

It has been a real pleasure for Guy to be the project manager of the Iba Renovation project. The hands on management of an ongoing project is a satisfying challenge compared to writing reports and proposals. Guy comes home tired and often a bit late

but usually happy with the progress of the work.

Since our previous letter a major portion of the overall renovation of the Iba site has been completed. There is a new roof and parapet wall, a new switch bay, and repaired walls that were completed at the end of April. Since May the work has moved indoors.

We were able to watch the office renovations get moving in May and by the end of June the office areas of the station were 90% complete and the transmitter hall work was getting under way. When we get back to the Philippines on August 1st we expect that Guy will be in the new office and that the transmitter hall renovation work will be almost 100% complete.

International Conference

Far East Broadcasting is not a top down organization in the traditional sense. All of our field leaders are local Christians from the countries where they minister. Each year the field leaders gather to take up the business of FEBC as a whole and to spend time worshiping and fellowshiping with each other. This annual meeting is known as the International Conference, or IC for short. This year the IC was hosted by FEBC Cambodia in Phnom Penh. Since we all have to leave the Philippines at least every 57 days to reset our business visas there, Chris and

Everyone in our family came away encouraged that what we are doing is important as we got the chance to hear the testimonies of our listeners that the field leaders shared. As a family we don't often directly meet our listeners, particular those who listen to shortwave, so hearing their stories of changed lives brings us joy.
