



Chris's Health Issues

After learning that Chris had a brain tumor in October and a visit to Mayo Clinic for a review of her case, Chris and Guy went back to Mayo in January for radiation therapy. Her Acoustic Neuroma was only medium size and so she had a single 45 min treatment with the gamma knife system which should kill the tumor. It took a few months after the treatment before Chris had all her energy back but it was much easier than brain surgery! She has been going to physical therapy to help treat her loss of balance due to the tumor. Guy helps with her exercises when he is home. She has continued to lose hearing in the affected ear.

We are now in the months where the tumor may swell some before it dies away. Chris has noticed that her balance is going down hill for a few weeks. We are asking for prayer that Chris won't have any vertigo or other more severe side effects during this time. We are also continuing to trust the Lord that the tumor has been killed. The odds are better than 95% but with the Lord odds are meaningless. What he purposes is what will happen.

We are praising the Lord for his help with the medical expenses, Mayo knocked almost \$5000 off of our bill when we shared our financial need with them.

Guy's Ministry Update

We are marking a new step in ministry at this writing. Guy's boss, Luke Cheng, has resigned after 7 years with FEBC and will now re-enter the business world. His passion for the Lord and for the ministry will be missed as well as well as his steady hand and ability to encourage the many different cultures of FEBC to work together. Guy will be taking over his responsibilities as the International Service Coordinator, a position that includes managing all of the International Service Team, not just the engineers. position is to fill in temporarily but based on the positive comments from our field leaders. Guy may become ISC as his full time assignment.

Project Report - Lampung

The work in our Heartline Lampung station has been going forward since last report and the new self supporting tower at the studio has been installed. It is a relief to have this done because everyone was worried that the old tower would fall down and hit someone.

Along with the new tower at the studio there will be additional equipment installed in the months ahead.

The Lampung transmitter site is also nearly finished. Guy's project monitor and friend, Owen Gabbie, reports that the TX room is ready and that we can place our order for a new Nautel transmitter for Lampung. The old transmitter has been off air more than on and with reduced power so they are excited to have their listeners receive a good signal again. Heartline Lampung has a great ministry in a difficult place so we are all excited to make the broadcasts stronger.

Twin Cities Project

The twin cities of this project are not to be found in Minnesota, they are in Mongolia. After almost ten years of prayer our FEBC Mongolia ministry has received licenses for FM broadcasting in Darhan and Erdenet. These are the 2nd and 3rd largest cities in Mongolia after Ulaanbator, the capital and home of our top rated WIND FM flagship station. Guy will be traveling to Mongolia at the end of June to coordinate the activities of the project, to meet the partners and to see the station sites.

Cambodia Project Update

Project work in Cambodia is really moving forward through the first part of 2014. In the last few months the new transmitter has been purchased and is ready to ship from the factory. This transmitter was delayed a couple of months because Nautel released a new, updated line of transmitters that are even more efficient and low cost to operate. Nautel, a good friend of our ministry, allowed Guy to change the order to the new type of transmitter. We are looking forward to being one of the first to bring a Nautel GV10 on air.

During the trip in May the final plans for the electrical works were signed off and the last of the details for the transmitter installation were finalized. Work on the ground will start about the time you read this prayer updated.

Guy will continue his travels to Cambodia for several years since there will be other phases of the project in order to update the studios, offices and equipment of our FEBCambodia ministry. The transmitter site work will finish by September and then the renovation of the main building can begin.

Ministering with our FEBCambodia staff is a joy but it is also humbling. They are very committed to the Lord and to his ministry. Their faith and obedience sets a standard for Guy to live up to.

Listener Response - Cambodia

Mrs. Lin lives in Phnom Penh and supports herself and her 2 sons by selling secondhand clothes. Her sister led her to the Lord. but she's unable to study the Bible because she never learned to read. The opportunity to attend school was not an option for her as a child. Once Mrs. Lin became a believer. she thought her problems would all disappear. She soon discovered that wasn't true. Her oldest son still disobeyed God, while her younger son used drugs and never came home. She became very discouraged. "I was so busy with my business," Mrs. Lin explained, "I didn't have time to attend church or a study group, so I prayed and asked God to provide a way for me to grow in my faith. A few weeks later, I turned on the radio and discovered FEBC's Family FM station. From that day on, I listened all the time. Family FM helped me understand what the Bible teaches."

Mrs. Lin's older son has now become a Christian and is studying in a Bible College, while her younger son stopped using drugs and is living with her. "One more thing that is a huge blessing for me," she added. "I am really brave now to share the love of God with others. I turn the volume up on my radio so my customers can also hear about God. Family FM is a good station; their programs have encouraged me. It is the only station I listen to. I love Family FM!"
