Currently we are in Union Grove, WI, where we are checking in with doctors for my knee replacement surgery scheduled for Monday May 4, at 10:25am All is on schedule for this surgery to take place.

We are also looking into the various options after our daughter's graduation from Shepherds College on this June 13. Currently we are considering and praying about the Catalyst program that allows her to live in a home with at least 2 other ladies with special needs. The idea is for these ladies to live independently as much as possible (appropriate independence) but with help available to help them in the areas in which they need help. This new move will be very exciting for her, but also there will be some costs involved as she sets up her new home. We are very proud of our daughter and her accomplishments and look forward to what God is going too do in her life, most of all we are proud of how she has kept shining for Jesus!
