We rejoice that Bolivia no longer has a dictator, things look like they will improve in the country. Sadly, we see the socialist opposition is not taking it quietly. However, we can rejoice because we still can proclaim the Gospel!

We also rejoice, that we are starting our journey home to Bolivia on the 15th of January, and we should be home by the 23rd, Lord willing.

One final reason to rejoice, the opportunity to return to the mission field and get back to working for the Lord in San Lorenzo, Bolivia. I know He has great things in store for us, and I know He does for all of you. Jer. 29:11
