This summer has been, as quoted by our team, an "eye opening", "amazing", "life-changing" experience, in which we "learned a lot" either about ourselves or about the culture of East Asia, and how God is working over here. After 6 weeks of making new friends on campus, taking language classes, learning a new culture, and trekking through crazy amounts of heat, we as a team initiated 360 conversations, gained 124 contacts, engaged in 131 Spiritual conversations, shared the Gospel 60 times, gave away 21 bibles to our friends, and 1 person prayed to receive Christ! We have a new sister in Christ, Praise the Lord!







God truly provided for us as we slowly adjusted to our new home city and felt Him preparing us to lead a team with the stressors of being overseas while being parents. We were even able to find an apartment very close to our university with a friendly, gracious landlord. She even speaks English! We also feel much more at ease as we got to practice the native language and take language classes that we will continue taking.

We only had 11 days to rest in the States before we headed to Chicago for a week of briefing and training with our whole team (right).
