IJM UCI chapter is a group of students concerned with international injustice issues, and acting as advocates for the oppressed. In response to the Bible's call to justice (Isaiah 1:17): Seek justice, rescue the oppressed, defend the orphan, plead for the widow, Sharon, Dustin and other member's goals are to: RAISE THEIR VOICES for the suffering through prayer and advocation, RAISE AWARENESS on our campus and community, and RAISE SUPPORT to help IJM rescue victims of oppression. Praise God for his mercy, and willingness to use Sharon and Dustin for His glory, as they step out in faith to connect with students outside of the Christian community.
