At the same time, it makes it worthwhile to see 7 new students place their trust into Jesus while seeing each of our teammates and own children grow in their knowledge of our great God.

Almost all of our best stories here revolve around the divine appointments God has set up with the most random people. Our closest friend, Ward, is a barista we met as we needed a coffeeshop to plan and talk through ministry. He first started asking us questions about why we moved here, but now each time he asks what we are working on we get the chance to talk to him about God. Thank you for being a part of this ministry, whether through giving of finances, praying alongside us, or encouraging us, your investments are having an eternal impact in the lives of our new friends here. We've seen God completely provide a community of friends and opportunities for us to share in this city, and are so excited to see 7 students place their trust in Him this year, and dozens more asking questions about Jesus, spirituality and the afterlife.

Even though there is so much to celebrate, we have a huge task before us as we prepare to enter our second year serving in East Asia. We need to raise another year of university tuition, team briefing and conference expenses, airfare for our entire family and other one-time costs totaling \$30,000. In addition, a number of supporters had to suspend their financial support with us this past year due to various reasons. As of today, we have a need to raise \$2,804 per month, and we are trusting God to provide as we share with and invite new partners to join our team, and ask current partners to increase their giving as they feel led. As soon as this team is complete and our financial goals are met, we can report to our assignment for our second year. Whether it is a single gift towards our one-time goal, a monthly contribution of \$100 or some other amount significant to you, we would be honored if you would consider partnering with us in some capacity.
