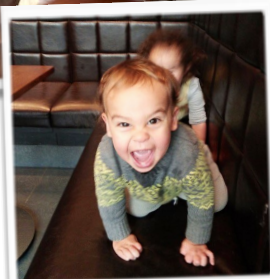


What is an Opera
