We’re excited to immerse ourselves in the city culture. We’ll all be living in a hostel right on Market Street and will be interacting with students daily. The students are required to have daytime jobs or volunteer positions so they can be a part of everyday city life. Outside of their jobs, we’ll be outreaching in the city, specifically to other college students, and we’ll be doing community service. Our main goal is to share the gospel with those around us.



Each staff member will be discipling a handful of students teaching them how to love and serve the Lord and others. We’ll be receiving training with the other staff while the students are working and each of us will have a job which we will pass on to a student when the summer is halfway over (July 12th). That is the fun part where the staff hand the project off to the students to lead completely. There will be some students that will direct the project, others that will handle finances, lead Bible studies, etc. We believe this creates a “greenhouse effect” where the students are feeding off of each other’s excitement for the Lord. We’ve seen students grow the most after the project staff leave. But we’re thrilled for the time we get to spend with them. We pray to impart what the Lord lays on our hearts to impact not only their summer but the rest of their lives.

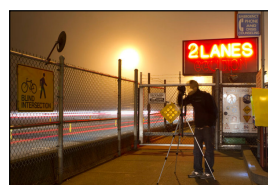
